1. June 2017 CAG Meeting Agenda and Details

- Suggested focus on the New York City Department of Environmental Protection (NYC DEP) Long-Term Control Plan (LTCP) for combined sewer overflows or the Riverkeeper/Newtown Creek Alliance Community Visioning Project.
